DIRECTIONS FOR USE

How to use: Apply as a spray, holding bottle about 12" from plants. Spray to cover all exposed plant parts including both upper and lower leaf surfaces. Use when bugs first appear. Avoid spraying blooms and tender, new foliage. Apply weekly or as need to control infestation.

Fruits & Vegetables: asparagus, beans, broccoli, Brussels sprouts, cabbage, carrots, cauliflower, celery, collards, corn, cranberries, cucumbers, eggplant, kale, lettuce, mustard greens, okra, onions, peas, peppers, potatoes, radishes, spinach, squash, strawberries, tomatoes, turnips.

Flowers & Ornamentals: aster, azalea, begonia, camellia, carnation, chrysanthemum, dahlia, daylily, dogwood, ground covers, geranium, gladiola, marigold, petunia, roses, salvia, shrubs.

Houseplants: African violets, dieffenbachia, dracaena, ficus, fuchsia, ivy, monstera, peperomia, philodendron, wandering Jew.

Controls: aphids, asparagus beetles, blister beetles, cabbage loopers, cabbageworms, Colorado potato beetles, cucumber beetles, diamondback moth larvae, fireworms, flea beetles, gnats, harlequin bugs, Japanese beetles, leathoppers, leaf tiers, mealy bugs, Mexican bean beetles, red spider, rose chafer, spider mites, stink bugs, thrips, webworms, whiteflies.
